Lyra and Lyra Direct SARS-CoV-2 Assay CPT and HCPCS Codes

Effective March 13, 2020, the American Medical Association (AMA) has released a new Current Procedural Terminology (CPT®) code for testing for severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2), coronavirus disease (COVID-19) using an amplified probe technique.

Effective April 14, 2020, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has released a new CMS Letter Ruling providing higher payment for high throughput SARS-CoV-2 testing and creating new HCPCS codes for the testing of SARS-CoV-2 using an amplified probe technique with the use of high throughput technologies as well as other techniques.

Quidel has identified the following codes as relevant to report the Lyra or Lyra Direct SARS-CoV-2 Assays. Please check with your payers to determine appropriate coding.

Code	Description	
87635	Infectious agent detection by nucleic acid (DNA or RNA); severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) (Coronavirus disease [COVID-19]), amplified probe technique	
U0003	Infectious agent detection by nucleic acid (DNA or RNA); severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) (Coronavirus disease [COVID-19]), amplified probe technique, making use of high throughput technologies as described by CMS-2020-01-R.
